

COVID 19 – Village Hall update – July 2020

Following the recently announced relaxation of the Covid 19 restrictions that caused the Village Hall to be closed several months ago at the start of lockdown, The Village Hall Management Committee have decided the Hall can be reopened from 1st August 2020 for any purpose specified as possible by Government guidelines.

In the first instance this will permit use by any of the groups previously having regular bookings in the Hall and any new hirers wishing to hire provided they are able to follow social distancing guidelines. The Committee have decided a social distancing recommendation of 2 metre will be required, This means that the maximum occupancy of the Main Hall will be 50 people and in the committee room 6 people. Throughout this period the Village Hall will try to accommodate as many hirers as possible but this may need some hirers being prepared to temporarily alter their regular dates / times.

Current Government guidelines will not permit the Hall being used for larger gatherings, events, parties or for any purpose where social distancing would be difficult or impossible to manage, we will update this notice as and when further relaxations allow us to relax the Halls restrictions further.

A full Covid 19 Village Hall policy will be published on this site shortly.

We hope users of the Hall will be able to recommence the activities they enjoyed prior to lockdown as soon as those activities restart. Please contact your activities organisers to establish when that will be.
